


This is a guide to help you better understand and use the Autobumper by Zora. This tool will automatically post bump/messages to any number of threads you like on Sythe.org.

Whitelisting

You can only use this program once you have been whitelisted. This is a one-time thing only and will only be required right after purchasing your license. Once your payment has been processed, you'll be given a link to download the Autobumper. When opening the program, you'll see the following message:




All you have to do here is paste the key in a message and send it to us. You will then be added to the whitelist and gain access to the tool.

Sythe Whitelisting

Your IP must be whitelisted on Sythe.org as well. You can do so by going to the Perk Manager: https://www.sythe.org/usercenter/perks-manage.html

At the very bottom you will find the 'Bumper Whitelist'. You must enter your IP4 address here and save it. It may take up to an hour to take effect.

You can use the 'What is my IP' button at the top of the Bumper or use the following website to find your IP4: https://whatismyipaddress.com/



Hosting the software

This software can only run on Windows 7 or higher. It does not work on Mac/Linux.

Running it 24/7

If you wish to run this software 24/7 you will either need a PC/laptop that's always turned on, or you need to rent a VPS. This program doesn't require much to run on, so you'll only need a very basic VPS/PC/laptop.

Running it only when you're online

If you're not a company with 24/7 support, you may want to consider only bumping when you're online. You won't need to spend any money on a VPS and you can shut your PC/laptop down at night.

All you have to do is create a desktop or start shotcut so you can easily access the program. Whenever you want the bumper to start, just open the program and click 'start'. The bumper should automatically save the current threads/settings, even when your PC is forced to shut down. If you start the program after a night of not bumping, it will start bumping right away.

Setting up the Autobumper

Below you'll find a list with all the options and settings the Autobumper has.

Save: saves your current settings and inputs. The tool should automatically save every now and then, but this option can be used if you want to be certain.

Styles: enabled you to set a number of styles to change the appearance of the tool. This setting is purely cosmetic.

What is my IP: shows you your current IP4 address. This can be used to whitelist at Sythe.org.

Help: opens the help page at iBump.io along with an FAQ.

Username: enter your Sythe name or e-mail address here. This will be remembered automatically.

Password: enter your Sythe password here. This will be remembered automatically.

2FA: click the box if you have 2FA enabled. Enter the 2FA code from your app once you're ready to login.

Login: click to connect your Sythe account with the bumper

Start: click once ready to start the tool. Click again to disable it.

Note: enter any information you'd like. This info is just for yourself that can help you remember what thread you've entered.


Thread ID: enter the thread ID of the thread you want to get bumped. You can find this by going to your thread and by then clicking 'thread tools'. See picture below:



Next Bump: you can customize when you'd like the thread to be bumped next. If the cell is empty, you can simply double click it and it will enter the current date + time. Once your thread has been bumped, it will automatically add 4 hours (or more, depending on your bump count) to this time.


Count: you can enter a number from 1 to 6 here. The number represents the amount of times you want to bump per 24 hours. The maximum you're allowed to bump is 6 times per day (every 4 hours).

Text: this is the message the tool will post to your thread. This can simply be 'bump' or you can add a link to your Discord server, website or other contact info.



Right clicking a cell

When right clicking a cell, you'll find the following options:



Clear cell: clears the selected sell
Clear row: clears the selected row
Delete row: deleted the selected row

Insert new row: adds a new row below the current selected cell

Insert new row at end: adds a new row at the bottom

Master column mode: enabled a special column at the top of your bumper.

Warning: this will replace the current top row!

Anything you enter in this row will be inserted in every cell below it. This is helpful when adding the same time, count or text to a lot of threads.
